WOULD YOU TAKE THIS OATH?

Lately there has been a lot of advertising on TV by the Shriners, those Freemasons in the red caps, asking for money to operate their hospitals for children. To become a Shriner, one must take a death oath to protect its so-called secrets (they really have no secrets). In the oath, the initiate kneels before a Muslim altar, puts his hand on what Obama reverently calls "the Holy Koran," and swears that, if he violates the oath, he will submit himself to the following punishment: "In willful violation thereof may I incur the fearful penalty of having my eyeballs pierced to the center with a three-edged blade, my feet flayed [cut across into thin strips] and be forced to walk the hot sands upon the sterile shores of the Red Sea, until the flaming Sun shall strike me with livid plague, etc, etc, etc."

And the death oath is sealed as the initiate calls upon **Allah** to help him to live up to his oath, as follows: "May Allah, the god of the Arab, Muslim and Mohammedan, **the god of our fathers**, support me to the entire fulfillment of the same, Amen, Amen, Amen." (emphasis mine)

BUT WHY DO THEY WEAR THE RED CAPS?

The red cap that all Shriners must wear is called a "fez." Its name is derived from the city of Fez in Morocco. In the 8th century, Fez was a Christian city; but it was conquered by Muslims. Its Christian inhabitants were slaughtered until their blood actually ran in the streets. The exultant Muslims celebrated the slaughter by dipping their wool caps in the blood of the Christians, and wearing them in triumph. Ever since that terrible time, the red fez celebrates the slaughter of the Christians and the establishment of Fez as a Muslim city with Allah as its god. It is the national head cover for men in such Muslim countries as Egypt.

BUT WHAT ABOUT THE HOSPITALS?

The Shrine hospitals and burn centers do a lot of good (although I know a woman who, as a helpless little girl, was raped in a Shrine hospital by two staff physicians, and was told that if she told anyone about it she would never walk again; you will not get a favorable endorsement of Shrine hospitals from her).

But even here, in their celebrated good work, there is deceit. Those hospitals and the imagery of a Shriner helping, or carrying, a crippled child, are a massively positive and sympathetic symbol. AL GORE SELLS HIS TV NETWORK TO THE ENEMY



CRUSHING HEARTBREAK WITH LITTLE MEANS OF COMFORT

In my opinion, the most evil, and by far the most cruel, of all of the shooting incidents in public places in the US—ever—is, by far, the recent massacre of teachers and small children at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut. The innocent victims, deliberately targeted, were not estranged fellow-workers, high school or college students. No, they were 5 and 6 year old 1st graders and their teachers. One of those little bodies had 9 gunshot wounds in it! The killer, Adam Lanza, first killed his mother, with whom he lived, and then broke into the school where he murdered six teachers and administrators, and 20 children. And then, as these cowards always do, he killed himself. Tragedy is an inadequate word here. The principal, staff members and teachers courageously and selflessly gave their lives attempting to save the children.

But there is another side to this story that is, in a way, even more tragic. New England is notorious as a spiritually dead part of the country, and

Newtown, Connecticut is a classic example. Nominally, it is largely a Catholic town; the rest mostly identify with no faith. The Orthodox Presbyterian Church in Newtown recently closed its doors and shut down.

Pastors gathered at the fire station, where parents waited to hear news of the casualties. Finally, after several hours of agonized waiting, one parent called out, “Are there any more survivors?” Governor Dannel Malloy, there to be with the families, said, “No.” Parents wailed and screamed; some went into catatonic shock.

Some evangelical pastors from outside Newtown were allowed to enter into the counseling; but, as Emily Belz of *World* observed, “The comfort from the local, mainline churches was thin.” Kathleen Adams-Shepherd, Priest of Newtown’s Trinity Episcopal Church, told her congregation, “Try to see just a pinpoint of light, if you can...Jesus will come, no matter what. **And so will Santa**, [emphasis mine] Amen.” Meanwhile, Father Robert Weiss, pastor of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, offered this homily to comfort his flock: “If we work together, good things can happen.”

The human tragedy is obvious and incalculable. But the spiritual emptiness, it seems to me, is also a tragedy. Many—perhaps most—of those surviving, grieving, families and friends, are left with their torn-apart hearts and shattered hopes, in a very real sense, alone. They are robbed of the comfort, healing and hope that can be so freely had, but are found only in a living faith in the living God. It must break the heart of God. (*World/USA Today*, et al)

In Rama there was a voice heard, lamentation and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not. (Matthew 2:18)

EPILOGUE. Many, especially humanist media commentators, have asked “Where was God during all of this?” The question is, of course, rhetorical, to make a point, and is usually intended to discredit those of us with religious faith, and to denigrate the very idea of faith in God. If I were asked that question I would say “He was in Heaven, looking on and grieving, just as He was when Herod slaughtered all children under the age of 2 within 10 miles of Bethlehem.” The questioner, of course, would not understand, and would probably think I made his point.

Mike Huckabee, former governor of Arkansas, was, predictably, asked this question by reporters about Sandy Hook, and his answer was profound. He said that God was there in the administrators and teachers who gave their lives trying to protect the children. His questioners had no ears to hear the wisdom in his reply.

When all is said and done, the answer lies in our increasingly secularized nation. After all, God has not been allowed in any public school since 1963.

A POINT TO PONDER

A LIFE LESSON: THE DANGER OF LOVING

To love, whether to love another person, an animal, or even a possession, a home, farm, or some precious souvenir with great sentimental value, involves great risk. Whatever the object of one's love is, there is the risk of pain¹. This risk is unavoidable, because there is always the chance of losing the object of one's love.

St. Augustine, in his classic work, *Confessions*, writes of the pain he experienced upon the death of a dear friend. His conclusion was that, because of the risk, it is wrong to give one's heart to anyone or anything but God, who will never forsake us. All other loves are to be avoided and rejected. I cannot agree. It may be valid for the most extreme of monastics; but for the rest of us, life without loving would be an awful way to live—a lonely, empty, kind of living death.

It is loving, I believe, that makes life worth living; even with its unavoidable heartbreaks, it is love that allows us to grow as God would have us to grow. If you have lived long enough to be reading this, you know that the risk is not only unavoidable, but the pain can be almost unbearable; broken hearts hurt much worse than broken legs. But, when the losses and heartaches come, we have the assurance that He is there to comfort and to heal. He is always “nigh unto them that are of a broken heart, and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.” The Hebrew for contrite, *dakka* also means “crushed like powder,” and that is how we can sometimes feel. We also have the promise that “He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.” The risk is real and ever-present; but God has provided the remedy for the pain¹. And, anyway, I wouldn't want to live without loving.

C.S. Lewis, whose writings moved me to write this piece, has summed it up in his stunningly concise way: “The only place, outside of Heaven, where you can be perfectly safe from all the dangers and perturbations of love, is Hell.”
